GENERAL BUSINESS MEETING

MARCH 22, 2010

The 42nd annual business meeting was held during a working luncheon at the IIAAA state athletic director's conference at the Marriott East Hotel in Indianapolis on March 22, 2010. The meeting was presided over by President Ed Gilliland.

The minutes of the March 23, 2009 meeting were presented by Secretary John Evers and approved as read by the membership. John Evers also presented the financial report for Treasurer Jim Brown. The checkbook balance was \$ 62, 223.57. The report was approved by the membership as read.

Bob Cuprisin presented the membership report. The membership at the beginning of the conference was 517. That was an increase from 512 at the end of last year. This is the second straight year over 500 members and the third overall year of dual membership with the NIAAA.

Mark DeHart presented a by-law change. The change called for an associate membership to be offered to those not serving as active athletic administrators. Associate members could attend the conference, take classes and be a non-voting member. All associates have to be at least 21. The change was approved by the membership as read.

Brian Avery presented a proposal to the IHSAA Executive Staff. The proposal called for soccer schools with less than 25 players to play a two-quarter JV game after a varsity game. The proposal was given a 100% vote by the membership. These numbers will be taken to Commissioner Rens.

Bernie Meyer proposed a slate of officers for the 2010-2011 year. The slate included:
