

IIAAA District IV Meeting Minutes  
September 22, 2010

1. Senior Director Paul Heidenreich called the meeting to order.
2. Pris Dillow-Executive Director of the IIAAA made the following comments:
  - a. National Conference will be December 14-18 in Orlando Florida.
  - b. If anyone knows of a business that may be interested in corporate sponsorship please forward that information to her.
  - c. Scholarship applications from the IIAAA and NIAAA should be sent to her. Deadline for applications is January 1 for IIAAA and February 28 for NIAAA.
  - d. Encourage coaches to participate in the Coaching Education classes sponsored by the NFHS.
  - e. Encouraged athletic directors to have emergency plans for athletic events.
  - f. Check the IIAAA web site often for information and news.
  - g. Newsletters are now e-mailed and athletic directors are encouraged to open it and read information for news.
3. Butch Zike-IIAAA President
  - a. Discussed state conference to be held March 19-22 at Mariott-East in Indianapolis. The Monday night social evening will be held again due to popular demand.
  - b. Soccer-New rule that a school can play a one-half of a JV contest if they have less than 25 players has helped a lot of schools and ad's seem to like the new rule.
  - c. Reclassification will be this year sometime in the spring. If interested in serving on one of the committees they should contact Butch.
  - d. \$500.00 that was sent to each school by the IHSAA was much appreciated by everyone.
  - e. The state banquet will change slightly. Winners of the various awards need to complete their packet and return on time.
4. IHSAA News and Announcements:
  - a. Encourage everyone in District IV to join state and national organizations.
  - b. District IV had an increase in membership last year.
  - c. Encourage middle school athletic directors to join the association.
  - d. Ticket prices at the sectional level will increase to \$6.00 in football and basketball this year.
  - e. Reclassification every 2 years starting in 2011
  - f. Soccer will go to two classes next year.
  - g. Volleyball tournament format is changing this year to a one game regional, four team semi-state and one state championship game in all classes.
  - h. Gymnastic state meet will be held at Ball State University. 11 schools still have gymnastics in our district.
  - i. Wrestling-concerns with team tournament. Some teams wrestled their JV athletes and only 1286 paid attendance last year with 8 teams participating.

- j. On line rules meetings will continue.
  - k. Tournament sites will be determined by the IHSAA. Schools may provide the IHSAA with information as to why they should host however the final decision will rest with the IHSAA. Expenses will be a factor in determining sites.
  - l. Streaming and broadcasting pros and cons were discussed.
  - m. Photographer's agreement with the IHSAA was discussed and a handout provided.
  - n. An increase in concussions has occurred in athletes this year. A handout was provided with information concerning concussions.
  - o. Rating of officials will be those officials on Arbiter who worked games involving your school from 2008-2010.
  - p. New AD workshop-If a new AD was unable to attend the workshop this past summer it will be offered at the state conference in March.
