1. Sectional Ticket Prices for football, boys and girls basketball will be \$6.00 for single session and \$9.00 season pass
2. Reclassification will take place every two years beginning in 2011. Athletic Directors were encouraged to volunteer to work on reclassification committees.
3. Sectional, Regional and Semi-State tournament sites will be determined by the IHSAA. Schools may provide the IHSAA with information as to why they should host but the decision will rest with the IHSAA. Location and Expense will be a factor in determining sites.
4. Soccer will go to two classes next year (2011). The cutoff line will be the same for boys and girls.
5. Volleyball tournament format change: Regional will be a 1 game on Tuesday following the Sectionals, Semi-State will be two games on the following Saturday and the State Finals will be two games.
6. Gymnastics State Championship at Ball State University. Sandy Seary informed the Athletic Directors that currently 75 High Schools have Gymnastics. If Gymnastics is eliminated another girls sport will have to be added (bowling, cheerleading, lacrosse) to be in compliance with Title 9
7. Wrestling – concerns with team tournament. Attendance was 1,286 with 8 teams participating. Some schools are not wrestling their Varsity team when they feel they do not have a chance at winning. Saving their wrestlers for individual tournament. Team wrestling past sectionals could be eliminated.
8. JV Soccer rule was discussed. Everyone was in agreement that the Varsity game should be played first so coaches will know how many player will be available for the JV. Also a fresh player should be available for the varsity game.

11. Rating Officials – only officials who worked a game/match involving your school from 2008-2010 will show up on the survey
12. Scholarships: IIAAA – son or daughter of IIAAA member. NIAAA-any athlete. IIAAA deadline is January 1st and NIAAA is February 28.
13. NEW AD Workshop – New ADS must attend the AD workshop. If you missed the workshop in July, you can attend the workshop which will be offered at the State Conference in March.
14. NIAAA dues increase - \$20.00, information can be located on www.niaaa.org
15. Stream Lining and broadcasting games – Channel 14 and Channel 25 are starting to streamline and broadcast athlete games. How much money should schools receive, will broadcasting a game effect the attendance of that game. (CRACKER BARRELL TOPIC FOR STATE CONFERENCE)
16. Photographer's agreement with IHSAA. Photographers can receive permission to from the IHSAA to take pictures during the state tournament. This does not entitle these photographers special treatment at games.
